



Council Lifetime Learning COVID-19 Safety Policies

BEFORE ATTENDING REMEMBER:

NCJW NY only allows vaccinated program participants admittance to the building, in the absence of any legally mandated exceptions. Participants will be asked to show proof of vaccination, original vaccination card and/or Excelsior Pass, upon first entry to the building. **PARTICIPANTS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED ENTRY WITHOUT PROOF OF VACCINATION.** After their first visit vaccinated participants will receive a key chain and will be asked to show this token each time they enter the building.

Participants are expected to stay at home if:

- They are experiencing any symptoms including fever over 100.4 F, chills, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle aches, headache, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, nasal congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting or diarrhea.
- They have traveled internationally. Participants should get a COVID test 3 to 5 days after any international travel and ensure a negative result before returning to Council House.
- They have a known close contact (being within 6 feet for at least 15 minutes over a 24 hour period) with someone while they had COVID. If so, they should stay home for 5 days and can only return after they receive a negative test 5 days following the exposure.

WHEN YOU JOIN US:

Participants will be encouraged to wash their hands or use sanitizer upon entry to the building.

Participants will be required to sign in during each class/program/event in order to allow contact tracing should a COVID-19 case be identified in that class.

Participants are expected to keep masks on over their nose and mouth at all times while in the building.

Participants should minimize walking around the building and only use restrooms on the floor they are already on, or the first floor.

The Café and lobby are not currently open for socializing.

Each room in use at Council House will either have a modern HVAC system or a HEPA filters offering a high level of air exchange to help decrease the risk of infection.

AFTERWARDS:

Please notify NCJW NY in the event of a positive COVID-19 test within two days after attending Council House.
